NYCHA Junior/Senior President

Qualifications for NYCHA President: To be eligible to run for Senior Youth President, candidates must have completed two terms on the NYCHA Governance (one term must be as a Senior National Officer).

- Relay all decisions from the NYCHA Board to the NCHA Youth Director.
- Lead meetings, both in person and on Zoom, effectively.
- Compile NYCHA meeting agendas for both Zoom and in-person sessions.
- Deliver a speech at the NYCHA Banquet during Youth Week.
- Maintain contact and collaborate with the Junior Youth President.
- Must participate in a minimum of 2 out of the 4 "Out of Arena" contests at the Youth Convention. (Speech, Photo, Art, and Essay)
- Must contact a minimum of 3 people per fundraiser
- Must be present for all meetings (Zoom option available)

NYCHA Junior/Senior Vice President

- Collaborate with the NYCHA President to prepare meeting agendas.
- Maintain contact and collaborate with the Junior Youth Vice President.
- Must participate in a minimum of 2 out of the 4 "Out of Arena" contests at the Youth Convention. (Speech, Photo, Art, or Essay)
- Must contact a minimum of 3 people per fundraiser
- Must be present at all meetings with the exception of 2 excused absences

NYCHA Junior/Senior Secretary

- Record detailed meeting minutes.
- Junior and Senior Youth must write minutes for each meeting.
- Junior Youth will review Senior Youth's published minutes.
- Senior and Junior will take turns every other meeting (In-person or Zoom) reading the minutes of the previous meeting after roll call, but the Senior minutes will always be the one read aloud.
- Update the NYCHA Governance Binder.
- Must participate in a minimum of 2 out of the 4 "Out of Arena" contests at the Youth Convention. (Speech, Photo, Art, or Essay)
- Must be present at all meetings with the exception of 2 excused absences

NYCHA Junior/Senior Reporter

- Complete writing assignments for the NCHA Chatter Quarterly.
- Communicate with NYCHA members from each circuit to collect event photos for advertisements and publications.
- Maintain contact and collaborate with the Junior Youth Reporter
- Both Senior and Junior complete a writing assignment for the Youth Convention program
- Must participate in a minimum of 2 out of the 4 "Out of Arena" contests at the Youth Convention. (Speech, Photo, Art, or Essay)
- Must contact a minimum of 3 people per fundraiser

• Must be present at all meetings with the exception of 2 excused absences

NYCHA Junior/Senior Promotions Director

- Manage all NYCHA fundraisers, ensuring communication with NYCHA Governance. (Stallion Service Auction, Wild Rag Fundraiser, and Jean Jacket Fundraiser)
- Maintain contact and collaborate with the Junior Youth Fundraising Director
- Must participate in a minimum of 2 out of the 4 "Out of Arena" contests at the Youth Convention. (Speech, Photo, Art, or Essay)
- Must contact a minimum of 3 people per fundraiser
- Must be present at all meetings with the exception of 2 excused absences
